#### **Annual Data Checks**

Thank you to everyone who has returned these documents. Please complete as soon as you can if you have not already done so. It is important we have your most up to date contact details and your child's medical information in case we need to contact you.

#### Covid

- Covid 19 symptoms 1 Children with mild symptoms E.g. runny nose, sore throat, slight cough but who are otherwise well, do not need to stay at home and can attend school.
- Covid 19 symptoms 2 Children should stay at home if they are unwell and have a
  high temperature. Children can return to school when they no longer have a fever
  and feel well enough to attend.
- Face coverings should be worn in school communal areas or worn by anyone who wishes to do so.

## **Parent Pay**

Parent pay is an online system, for payments being made to the school. Money for school lunches, and milk for any pupil should be paid via parent pay. Please note, P1, P2, P3, P4 and P5 are now entitled to a free school lunch. P6 and P7 pupils pay via parent pay. P1 pupils have received their parent pay activation letters. Please let us know if you need any help with setting up parent pay accounts.

Please note that milk needs to be pre ordered, order your child's milk online on parent pay at least the day before they are due to have it. Milk costs 26p.

### **Pupil Equity Fund**

Dalserf Primary School has been allocated £18,375.00 in Pupil Equity Funding for the new school session 2022-2023. This is a slight increase from the anticipated amount in June. The fund will be used to support targeted children to help remove barriers to their learning. 5% of this sum (£918.75) will be allocated as part of a participatory budget for the community of the school to use on a chosen project. A Google form will be shared so parents can vote for their preferred choice.
