Dear Parents/Carers,

Covid Update

The Scottish Government have indicated that from 28th February the following key changes can be made:

- Face coverings staff continue to wear these in communal areas or where social distancing cannot be maintained
- Assemblies removing the remaining restrictions on assemblies
- Transition visits P1 and P7 visits can now resume fully if appropriately risk assessed
- School Trips removing restrictions with appropriate risk assessments in place
- **Staggered start and finish times** removal of 2.55pm finishing time for Room 1 and Room 3. From Monday 28th all classes will leave on the 3pm bell via the P1-3 gate.



Traffic Management Audit

A reminder that the drop off bays should be available for mini-buses and taxis who drop off/pick up children before and after school, these are not parking spaces. Please use the designated visitors parking spaces or alternatively park out with the school grounds or use the car park at the side of the school. As you can appreciate, it can become very congested at peak times and your child's safety is of paramount importance and therefore wish to reduce the chances of potential road accidents or damage to vehicles.
