
#### **Dance Festival**

#### **Covid Update**

As well as the recent letter shared on the School App from Professor Jason Leitch the National Clinical Director regarding changes to the advice being followed by Educational Establishments, the Scottish Government have indicated that from 18<sup>th</sup> April the following key changes can be made in schools:

- **Face coverings** No change. We will receive a further update from the Scottish Government on 18<sup>th</sup> April 2022.
- **Test and Protect and Lateral Flow Testing** schools asymptomatic testing programme will end.
- Warn and Inform Letters There will no longer be a requirement to issue these letters.
- **Restrictions on parents/carers/wider family** No longer any restrictions entering school buildings. However, the schools routine preventative measures will still apply. Eg hand hygiene, face coverings and general awareness and distancing where possible.
- NHSL Public Health Advice Do not be complacent. Continue with our very good infection controls and Lateral Flow testing up until 18<sup>th</sup> April. Be vigilant.









• Start and finish times- From Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> April, all classes will enter and leave via the P1-3 (main gate) and line up in their classes.

#### **School Lunches**

From Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> April, school meals for Primary 6 and 7 children will cost £2.00. Primary 1-5 meals will

continue to remain free of charge. However, milk for all children will now cost 24p. Please ensure Parent Pay accounts are updated to cover these increases if your child wishes a school lunch or milk.

#### **Indoor Shoes**

Please check your child's bag as staff have sent home their indoor/gym shoes for you to see as sometimes at this time in the school session children can take a growth spurt and start to outgrow their clothes and footwear.
