Literacy

In Literacy this term, P3/4 have been learning how to write an imaginative story based on "The Papaya who Spoke".

We have learned to retell the story with actions and we have changed it to make our own version of the story.





Numeracy

Primary 3 have been adding and subtracting tens and units using a written calculation.

Primary 4 have been adding and subtracting hundreds, tens and units using a written calculation.
