




Numeracy

This term we began consolidating our whole numbers knowledge. We then began developing it further by extending our knowledge of place value, addition, subtraction and rounding.

We have also developed our measuring, accuracy and drawing skills through our angles topic. The children have successfully transferred this knowledge to measure and explore angles within the environment.
