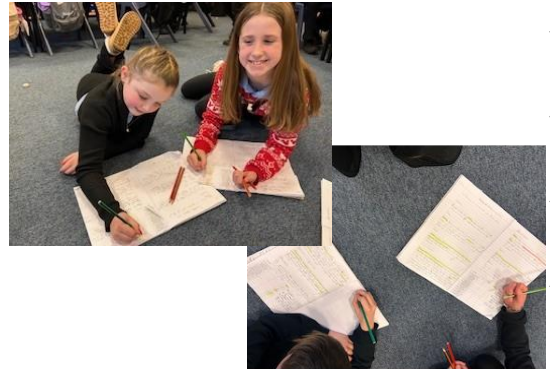


## Room 4 - P6/7

#### Literacy

For writing this term, we have been learning about information report writing. We explored the structure of an information report, and the importance of titles and subheadings for the reader. We have also developed our vocabulary by exploring the use of adverbs and VCOP to up-level the beginning of our sentences. Once writing was complete, the children enjoyed engaging in some peer and self-assessment to provide constructive feedback to their peers.



#### Numeracy

In Numeracy and Maths, the children have been exploring Information Handling and Statistics. We have learned about a variety of ways to display and interpret data such as bar and line graphs, frequency tables and pie charts. Additionally, we have further developed our knowledge and understanding by creating bar graphs/pie charts from data showed in frequency tables. We will continue to extend this learning by carrying out our own questionnaires and displaying our results in a graph of our choice.
